Wi-Fi on European flights

FINNAIR

Finnair has launched Wi-Fi connectivity on its European flights, with six of the carriers narrow body Airbus fleet now fitted with the Viasat technology.

Twenty of its short-haul aircraft will be fitted by the end of this summer, with the rest of its fleet expected to be connected by summer 2019. Access is currently free during a two-month testing period, during which Finnair will gather information on system functionality and feedback on the overall customer experience. Pricing beyond this period will be announced in the autumn.

She originally worked with Marine Travel from 2006 to 2012 in our ticketing department and left to have her second child.

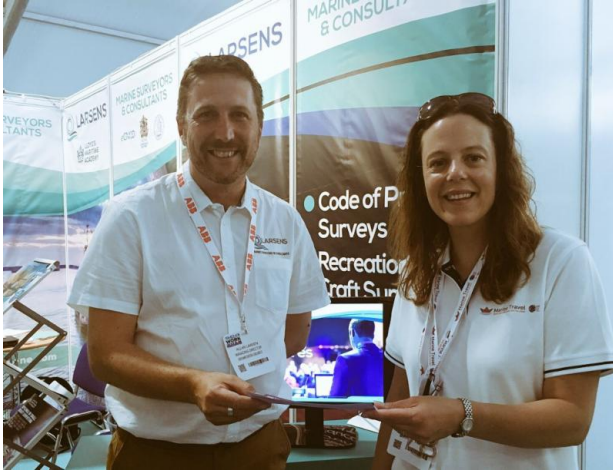
Sarah has two children and her spare time evolves around them and the family. She enjoys motorbike racing and you can often find her at the track with the family.
