### Qatar Airways to introduce new economy class seating

The new seats have a semi-fixed back shell so passengers can recline the seat from the take-off and landing position of 6 degrees recline to a maximum 19 degree recline without causing problems for the passenger in the seat behind. The seat will have new 13.3 inch 4K inflight entertainment screens and USB Type-C with fast charging capabilities. Connectivity will also be improved, with “up to 10 times faster broadband, as well as more than 4,000 entertainment options on Qatar Airways’ Oryx One in-flight entertainment system”. ### Priority Pass to trial fast-track lanes

Priority Pass is trialing a new scheme that will give access to express lanes at security and passport control at select airports. Priority Lane will initially be available for pre-booking by UK members, with prices from £4 in addition to their membership fee.

Participating airports will be:

- Orio al Serio International Airport, Bergamo, Italy – security
- Palermo Airport Falcone Borsellino, Sicily, Italy – security
- London Gatwick – security and passport control
- Leeds Bradford Airport, UK – security
- Muscat International Airport, Oman – security and passport control
- Bahrain International Airport, Bahrain – passport control

### Airline Updates

- [Flybe](#) will commence a new route from Guernsey to Heathrow starting from the 31st March along with a increase in service for Edinburgh to Heathrow with 6

- flights daily.
- Aberdeen-based [Loganair](#) will operate its first ever flights from London Southend. The routes in question are to Aberdeen, Glasgow and Stornaway. Flights to Aberdeen start on May 12th with Glasgow and Stornaway following on May 28th.
- [Alitalia](#) will be serving Edinburgh for the first time ever this summer. Please note that this will be a once weekly seasonal service between Milan and the Scottish capital. Although Alitalia is deploying an Airbus A320 it will operate between June 8th and August 31st only.
- [Emirates](#) has announced the launch of a second daily flight from Dubai to London Stansted starting 1st July. The additional flight means that Emirates customers will now have 11 daily flight options to and from three London airports

Dubai International has announced plans to close its southern runway for a period of 45 days to allow for upgrade works to take place. The work is scheduled to take place from April 16th to May 30th, when the airport says that “passenger traffic historically ebbs due to a seasonal lull”.

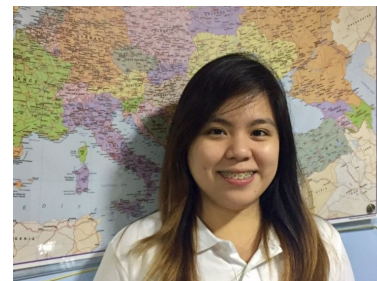
## Meet the team
