



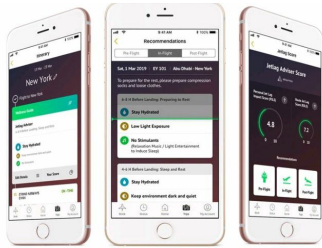

Etihad introduces a new wellness solution

Etihad and Panasonic Avionic Corporation have announced a new partnership to develop and trial new passenger wellness solutions. The first service will offer personalised jet lag advice, and will be integrated into the carrier's app.

The Jet Lag Adviser will take individuals' information including "chronotype, circadian rhythms, height, weight, the nature of travel, and travel information such as flight times, routes and zones", to produce jet lag reduction plans.

Passengers will receive a score based on a combination of generic route-based and personalised stats, giving them a summary of how severe jet lag may be on their route, along with a personalised pre-flight, flight and post-flight plan, with jet lag reduction tips for each phase, such as sleep, exposure to light, exercise, hydration and food intake.

Flybe announced the details of a base review as part of its previously stated strategy to reduce its aircraft fleet and return all of its 118-seat Embraer 195 aircraft to its lessors, of which six will be returned this financial year. The 78-seat Bombardier Q-400 will continue as the backbone of Flybe's network, being the ideal aircraft for the regional network it provides to connect the UK and the UK regions with the rest of the world.



The airline will stop jet flights from Cardiff, Doncaster, Exeter and Norwich, but will continue with Q400 flying. With effect from the start of the 2019-20 Winter programme.



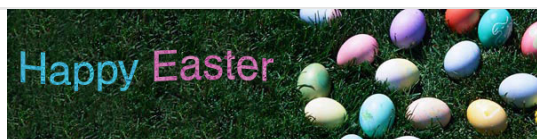
Airport and Airline Updates

- Start-up carrier [Great Dane Airlines](#) is set to launch flights from Denmark to Dublin, Edinburgh and Nice this summer. The airline will be based at Aalborg airport and will operate 118-seat Embraer E195 aircraft. Twice weekly flights to Dublin will launch on 21st June, followed by Edinburgh on 24th June and Nice

(weekly) on 26th June.

- From 21st April [Flybe](#) will be operating a daily flight between London Heathrow and the Isle of Man.
- [British Airways](#) has announced plans for a new year-round route between London Gatwick airport and Milan Bergamo.
- [SAS](#) has started its new route this month from London Stansted to Copenhagen.

[Manchester airport](#) has opened a new pier at its Terminal 2, as part of a £1 billion transformation programme. The 216-metre long facility – which the airport points out is “longer than Manchester’s Beetham Tower is tall” – will be used by all carriers operating out of T2. The new pier is the latest phase of the airport’s decade-long transformation programme, which also saw a multi-storey car park open today. The new pier has 11 gates and airbridges, and over 1,400 seats for passengers.



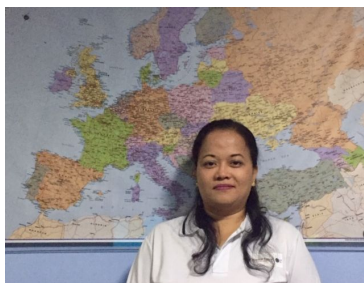
