Gatwick

**Gatwick airport station to get
£150 million upgrade**

The UK government has announced a £150 million investment to upgrade the rail station at Gatwick airport. The funds will be used to double the size of the station concourse, as well as to widen two platforms to reduce congestion, and to add five new lifts and eight escalators.

Gatwick said that the works would "reduce train delays caused by platform overcrowding and congestion, while also improving passenger experience by providing easier connections to other destinations".

The upgrade project will begin in spring 2020 and take around two years to complete, with works being "sequenced to ensure minimum disruption"



Airline Updates

- From the 4th October [British Airways](#) will cease flights operating from London Heathrow to Kiev and St Petersburg.
- [Lufthansa](#) will commence a new service from Newcastle to Munich from Feb 2020.
- [Emirates](#) will launch a four times weekly service between Portugal's second largest city, Porto, and Dubai, from 2nd July.
- [British Airways](#) is to increase its winter schedule between Scotland and London's Heathrow Airport, operating almost 200 flights a week from October 2019 to March next year. The frequency increases on services from Edinburgh, Glasgow and Aberdeen to Heathrow will start in the week beginning October 27th.
- Non-stop service begins on 22nd December from Mumbai to New York with [Delta](#).
- [Brussels Airlines](#) will be operating daily (except Saturday) flights from September between Bristol and Brussels.

Carlisle Lake District Airport has restarted commercial passenger operations after a 26 year break. Regional airline Loganair will now provide connections to London Southend, Belfast City and Dublin.

Flights will run five days a week, with no flights on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Arriving and departing passengers will be offered a free minibus connection to the city centre.



The Red Arrows will join forces with a specially decorated British Airways 747 at the [Royal International Air Tattoo](#) on Saturday, 20th July.

The special Boeing 747 has been painted in the airline's predecessor British Overseas Airways Corporation (BOAC) livery to mark British Airways' centenary this year.
