### Supplier of the month - LOT Polish Airlines

Established in 1929, LOT is one of the oldest operating airlines. Now a modern airline with a fleet of over 70 aircraft and a network to over 100 destinations, LOT has been at the forefront of passenger air travel for 90 years.



LOT is the only airline to offer a 3-cabin service between London City Airport and Europe. 4 new Embraer E190's were acquired to operate this route.

This aircraft offers exceptional comfort with its  $2 \times 2$  configuration and a seat pitch of 31'' with adjustable headrests.



With a modern fleet of 787 Dreamliners exclusively operating to long haul destinations, LOT offers a 3-cabin service across the entire network, except for domestic connections.

2019 saw LOT open 3 new direct flights from London City Airport to Warsaw, Budapest and Vilnius. Flights operate to each destination twice a day during the week with one flight a day on the weekend.



#### **Airline Updates**

- Lufthansa are launching a new route to Munich 6 days per week from February 2020. This route will complement the existing Dusseldorf service with Eurowings.
- Loganair launch Bergen (April 2020) and Guernsey (May 2020) in addition to their existing routes to Stavanger, Brussels, and Aberdeen from Newcastle.
- British Airways will launch a new route from April 2020 from London Gatwick to Antalya, Turkey.
- Austrian Airlines is set to begin its first route from Birmingham Airport next year. Service to Vienna will begin on 1st January 2020 and operate on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays.

### **Manchester Airport**

Manchester airport has launched a new partnership with Airportr, allowing travellers to have luggage collected from their home, office or hotel and checked in at the airport



ahead of departure. The service costs from between  $\pounds 20$  and  $\pounds 36$  for one piece of luggage (depending on collection location), with additional bags costing  $\pounds 7$  each.

A driver collects and weighs the luggage, scans passengers' passports and boarding passes, and seals the luggage in coded, tamper-proof bags.
