## Airline Updates

- **Lufthansa** will launch a twice-daily service between Bristol and Frankfurt next spring. The year-round flights will begin on March 30th, 2020, and be operated by an Embraer 190. They will depart Frankfurt at 0820 and 1630, with the returns from Bristol leaving at 0935 and 1750. On Saturdays only the evening service will run.
- **Swiss** will commence a service to Osaka Japan from 1st March 2020. Osaka, also known as "Japan's kitchen", lies at the heart of Japan's main island. From here you can reach the cities of Kobe, Nara and Kyoto, which are among the most beautiful in Japan. SWISS will fly on Mondays, Wednesdays and every day from Friday to Sunday.
- **Austrian Airlines** will launch flights between Vienna and Boston on March 29th 2020. Flights will run four-times weekly, increasing to six-times weekly in mid-April (Tuesday to Sunday). The nine-hour route will be operated with a 211-seat Boeing 767.

## Flybe announces a new name

Regional airline Flybe is to be rebranded as Virgin Connect, following its acquisition by a Virgin Atlantic-led consortium. In July, the European Commission approved the sale of Flybe to the newly-formed Connect Airways, which comprises Stobart Group and Cyrus Capital as well as Virgin.



A new website, [virginconnect.co.uk](http://virginconnect.co.uk), states that the brand will say "goodbye to purple and hello to red". It confirms that bookings for next year can be made at [flybe.com](http://flybe.com) and existing bookings will not be affected.
