TAP Air Portugal


TAP is the leading airline to Portugal from the UK with 82 weekly flights between London Heathrow, Gatwick and Manchester to Lisbon and Porto.



The TAP Lisbon hub, is a key European gateway at the crossroads of Africa, North, Central and South America, where TAP stands out as the international leading carrier in operation to Brazil.

The company's network currently comprises 90 destinations in 36 countries worldwide. At present TAP operates approximately 3,000 weekly flights with a modern fleet of 85 Airbus aircraft and 21 aircraft in TAP Express livery, operating the company's regional network, and totals 106 aircraft in the fleet, as a whole.

TAP has recently started a double daily flight from Dublin to Lisbon, in addition to services already available from the UK. On this route TAP will offer both business and economy class cabins.





Airline Updates

- Air France in late-February 2020 plans to discontinue Brest – Amsterdam service, currently served 3 times weekly. Last flight is scheduled on 29th February.
- Sleeping cabins are available for tired passengers in need of a nap before or after a flight at Istanbul Airport. iGA cabins can be booked at the Airport and have a storage section and USB port and socket for charging.
- British Airways will fly between London Heathrow and Newquay's Cornwall Airport this summer.



UK Rail Update

Network Rail is reminding passengers that no trains will run in or out of London King's Cross Station for two weekends, as major work continues as part of the East Coast Upgrade. Passengers are urged not to travel to and from London on the East Coast Main Line on Saturday, 29 February and Sunday 1st March as no trains will run into King's Cross. Over this weekend, Network Rail engineers will continue to relocate sections of the signalling system from King's Cross to a state-of-the-art centre in York.
